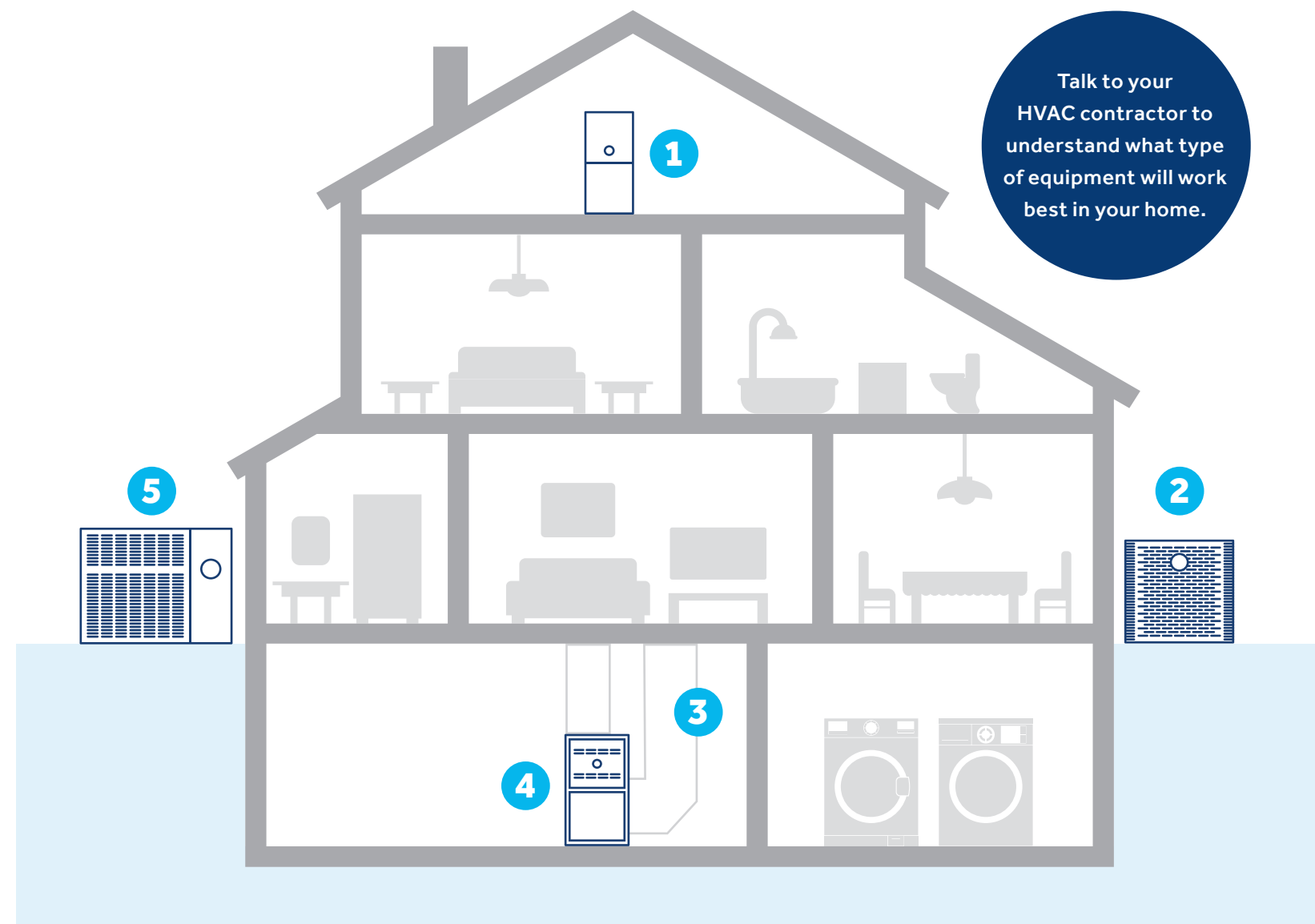

AFUE
(Annual Fuel Utilization Efficiency)

AFUE measures how much natural gas your furnace is turning into heat. The higher the AFUE rating, the more efficient your furnace is.

SEER2
(Seasonal Energy Efficiency Ratio)

SEER2 measures the cooling efficiency of an air conditioning unit over a cooling season, not just the maximum. The higher the SEER2, the more efficient your cooling system will be.

Low-NOx and Ultra-Low NOx
(Gas Furnaces/Packaged Units)

Units designed to emit lower levels of nitrogen oxides (NOx) compared to standard units.

Air Conditioners

- Up to 16 SEER2 single-stage
- Up to 17 SEER2 two-stage
- Up to 22 SEER2 inverter models with continuous speeds for increased efficiency



Heat Pumps

- Up to 16 SEER2 single-stage top-discharge
- Up to 21 SEER2 inverter top-discharge
- Up to 19 SEER2 inverter side-discharge models for limited space installations



Packaged Units

- Air conditioner, heat pump, and gas electric options
- Up to 15 SEER2 models (heat pump & gas electric)
- Low-NOx and Ultra-Low-NOx models available



Air Handlers

- Multi-position one-piece or two-piece design
- High efficiency variable speed options available



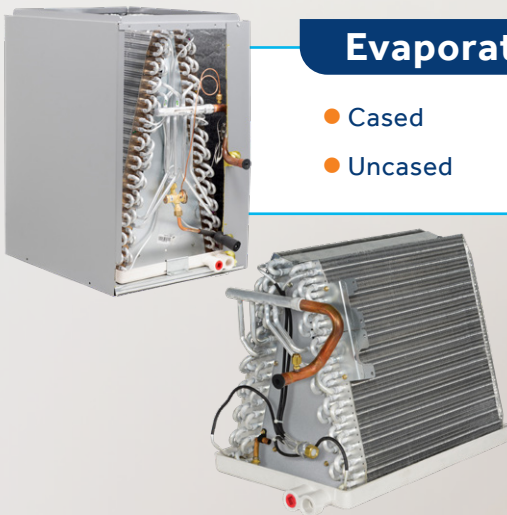
Gas Furnaces
