

GEOSPRING™ HYBRID WATER HEATER

Proof of qualified energy property for claiming tax credits for residential heat pump water heaters

The Tax Relief Extension Act of 2015 extended the period in which the section 25C tax credit can be claimed for purchasing certain energy efficient property for use in existing homes, including a retroactive provision for certain purchases made in calendar year 2015.

GeoSpring heat pump water heater models GEH50DEED, GEH50DFEJ, GEH50DEEJ, GEH80DFEJ and GEH80DEEJ qualify for a tax credit of \$300.

GE Appliances certifies that the above models, if purchased and installed between January 1, 2015 and December 31, 2016 in a homeowner's principal residence, meet the criteria of "Qualified Energy Property" as set forth by Section 25C of the Internal Revenue Code.
